When the time came for their purification according to the Law of Moses, they brought [Jesus] up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord.

(Luke 2:22)

The month of February is known as the month of love. St. Valentine's Day serves as the heart of the month. In the Church Year, the month begins with the celebration of the Feast of the Purification of Mary and the Presentation of Our Lord. This Feast is celebrated on February 2 and also known as Candlemas.

In ancient custom, candles were brought to the church to be blessed. These candles serve as a symbol of Christ as the Light of the world (John 8:12). We use this time to reflect on Jesus as the Light of the world—the Light which the darkness cannot overcome (John 1:5).

With this Feast, we recognize and celebrate both the Incarnation and the Virgin birth. We also celebrate Jesus fulfilling the Levitical laws surrounding childbirth. Under the Mosaic Law, when a child is born, mother and child are ceremonially unclean until the time of their purification. For a son, this was forty days after birth (Leviticus 12:2-4). The firstborn child is to be set apart for the LORD (Exodus 13:12).

As Mary's firstborn son, Jesus fulfills the Law for every child. As the Son of God, the "firstborn of all creation" (Colossians 1:15), He fulfills the Law for every firstborn.

His fulfillment of these laws shows His love for you. His love fulfills even the most minute detail of the Law. His love fills the entirety of your life. His love purifies you. Jesus was presented before the LORD at the Jerusalem Temple so that He might present you before Him in Heaven.

The Presentation of Our Lord shows us a greater love than we can even imagine from Valentine's Day. A love that has been since before the foundation of the world (John 17:14). A love that will last long after the heavens and the earth pass away (Luke 21:33).
